CLUB BANNER RECOGNITION OPPORTUNITIES

Here is a summary of the changes for the 2015-16 club banners:

- 1. 100% EREY Sustaining Member banner (merging the 100% EREY & 100% Sustaining Member banners)
- *This banner recognizes giving to our Annual Fund at the sustaining level- support for today!
- 2. 100% Foundation Giving banner (new banner)
- *This banner recognized support for ALL fund designations within The Rotary Foundation (including the Annual Fund, PolioPlus Fund, Endowment Fund, an approved global grant, etc.)
- 3. 100% Paul Harris Society Club (new banner)
- *This banner recognizes clubs where all of their members have given outright at least US \$1,000 to the Annual Fund, PolioPlus Fund and/or an approved global grant.

Note: Final banner certification is processed by The Rotary Foundation following the close of the Rotary year. Club banners earned for the prior Rotary year are sent to the current district governor in October/November.

BANNER REPORTS

These reports display a club's current progress toward becoming an 100% Foundation Giving Club, a Every Rotarian, Every Year/Sustaining Club (formally called 100% Sustaining Member Club), and the Top Three Per Capita in Annual Fund Giving banner recognitions.

- -Club leadership can use the "Club Foundation Banner Report."
- -District leadership can use the "Foundation Banner Recognition Status"

As of 2015-16 Rotary year, new club members will not be included in the participation

requirements for club banners. This includes Rotarians who joined Rotary or transferred from another club during the current Rotary year. However their contributions will still be used for calculating per capita. In other words your club will not be penalized for adding new members during the Rotary year. This will give you time to share The Rotary Foundation with new club members so they can join in your club's culture of giving.

CLUB FOUNDATION BANNER REPORT

Here are some descriptions and definitions that appear at the bottom of the Club Foundation Banner Report to help you understand how to read the report.

*Starting in 2015-16, new Rotarians who joined in the selected Rotary Year are not included in the totals for TRF Giving Rotarians or Sustaining Member Rotarians.

TRF Giving Rotarians (starting in 2015-16): The number of active Rotarians who have contributed some amount to any fund of The Rotary Foundation in the selected Rotary Year. Every Rotarian Every Year (EREY) Rotarians (prior to 2015-16): The number of active Rotarians who have contributed some amount to the Annual Fund (SHARE, Areas of Focus and World Fund) in the selected Rotary Year.

Rotary Foundation Sustaining Member (RFSM): The number of active Rotarians who have contributed US\$100 or more to the Annual Fund (SHARE, Areas of Focus and World Fund)in the selected Rotary Year. Contributions are cumulative throughout the Rotary year. Non TRF Giving Rotarians, Non Sustaining Member Rotarians and Non EREY Rotarians: The number of individuals who have not contributed the any fund (TRF Giving), the Annual Fund (EREY), or a minimum of US\$100 to the Annual Fund (Sustaining Member) in the selected Rotary Year.

Annual Fund Per Capita: The total amount, in U.S. dollars (USD), contributed to the Annual Fund (SHARE, World Fund, and Areas of Focus) divided by the 1-July members (for new clubs this is current members). The contributions can come from any source (members, non-members, clubs and other organizations).

Average TRF Giving: The total amount, in U.S. dollars (USD), contributed to any Rotary Foundation fund or grant, divided by the 1-July members (for new clubs this is current

members). The contributions can come from any source (members, non-members, clubs and other organizations).
